No cross entries between classes 1, 2 & 3

 2. Halter, English Type (Open to Saddlebreds, Morgans, Arabians, Hackneys, etc)
 3. Halter, Hunt Type (Open to any horse suitable for over fences, eventing)
 4. Halter, **BEGINNER** - Open to all ages. Handler has no previous show experience
 5. Sport Horse In-Hand (can cross enter from 1, 2 & 3)

GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION:

All classes except for Trail will be run indoor in the new Horse-A-Rama multi-purpose agricultural barn!

FEES – No Office Fee, \$4 / Horse for AQHA entries only,

\$5 / open class, \$8 / AQHA class, No Fee-Stick Horse class

COGGINS – Current Original Negative Coggins required; will be scanned for office records.

HALTER CLASSES – Show halters are not necessary; any clean stable halter is appropriate.

BEGINNER CLASSES – It is assumed that the exhibitor has little or no previous show experience. Exhibitors 7&under may have an adult present in the ring for safety.

AQHA CLASSES – Must be a current youth or amateur member in good standing, or purchase membership in show office. AQHA registration papers must be presented. All AQHA classes will follow the current AQHA rule book.

WARM-UP CLASSES – Judged classes; you may be asked to do more than just walk & trot!

TRAIL CLASS - will be open for practice throughout the day, up until the actual class times.

PATTERN BOOK – Available for purchase in the show office.

ATTIRE, Open Classes – “Show clothes” are not required! Proper footwear is required (boots or shoes with 1 inch heels). Helmets are required for all riders under 18.

ATTIRE, AQHA Classes – Western: Hat, long sleeve shirt with collar; jeans/slacks with belt, boots, chaps optional. HUS: Hunt cap/helmet (helmet mandatory under 18), long sleeve shirt with collar, conservative hunt coat & breeches, boots.

GROOMING OF HORSES - Horses are expected to be clean; trimming, braiding, banding is not required for **open classes only**. AQHA classes follow current AQHA rules.

TACK - Saddles and bridles are expected to be CLEAN, and appropriate for the division; show gear is not expected.

DOGS - Please leave at home. If present, must be on leash, in hand.

LUNCH – Will be available on the grounds
